HEALTH MINISTER PHILPOTT AND MARGARET TRUDEAU READ FROM THE SAME PLAYBOOK

Margaret Trudeau, mother of Prime Minister, Justin Trudeau, has acknowledged that she had been a heavy smoker of marijuana in order to self-medicate for her bi-polar mental condition. She said that every time she was hospitalized for her mental condition, it was preceded by her heavy use of marijuana.

Quitting marijuana, she admitted, was an important part of her recovery.

On April 2, 2016, Margaret Trudeau spoke at a Catholic High School in Mississauga, Ontario on marijuana, advocating that marijuana be regulated, even though she admitted "evidence shows that marijuana is damaging to children's brains."

But then, startlingly, after admitting her own personal problems with marijuana, she went on to say: "after 18 years of age, go head," eliciting laughter from the crowd. Was she confused? More than a little.

This contradiction on marijuana use seems to be part of her son, Justin Trudeau's, policy as well.

On April 20, 2016, the federal Minister of Health, Jane Philpott, told the UN Special Session of the General Assembly in New York (UNGASS 2016), that legislation on marijuana will be introduced in the spring of 2017. Such a policy will breach three UN treaties on illicit drug use signed by Canada. This doesn't appear to be a problem for her.

Ms. Philpott held a private meeting for Canadian NGO's during the UN meeting. At this meeting, Ms. Philpott stated that Canada would no longer be emphasizing the harms, rather, the benefits of waiting until age 18 to use pot!



Pamela McColl, a member of "Smart Approaches to Marijuana" (SAM), an international organization committed to science over propaganda on marijuana, and who represented the Drug Prevention Network of Canada (DPNC) at this meeting, personally spoke to Ms Philpott. She was utterly amazed by the Minister's comments on the planned changes in the marijuana law.

Pamela stated:

I found the Health Minister in a quiet corner and approached her with a friendly smile, so she did rise to shake my hand and speak with me. Ms Philpott told me that they [the government] would no longer be emphasizing the harms, rather the benefits of waiting till age 18, to use marijuana. I responded that, as a neuroscientist, I found this approach unwise because the brain is still developing and why would they want to interfere with that development (possibly as late as age 28 for males). She responded that they are doing it anyway, and by regulating they will have more control. I then asked her what she thought about the Colorado data showing an increase in youth use with legalization (+20% for those aged 12-17 and +46% for those 18 and over). She responded that she didn't believe that data! We then talked about how it took 50 years to cut by half the use of the legal drug tobacco and that the other legal drug, alcohol, remains the leading problem drug in the world today. At that point she became a little irritated, said she was due on stage to give a talk, and excused herself.

Is it too much to ask the Trudeau government to have a coherent policy on marijuana? Apparently so. *

THE UN MEETING ON DRUGS

The UN held a meeting on drugs in New York City, on April 19 to 21, 2016, for the first time in twenty years. The meeting is called the UN General Assembly Special Session, 2016 referred to as UNGASS 2016. Its purpose was to review the progress made in the implementation of a UN strategy on the world drug problem up to the target year of 2019. It included an assessment of the achievements and challenges in countering the world drug problem within the framework of the three international drug control conventions and other relevant United Nations treaties.

Over 300 non-government organizations, strong in support of drug prevention, arrived at UNGASS 2016 under the banner - "Prevent, Don't Promote". http://preventdontpromote.org/resources/

They were working against many organizations funded by US billionaire, George Soros, who spent \$70 million at this meeting trying to bring about changes in the world legalization of drugs. He funded 213 organizations attending the meeting, including Canadian organizations. According to John Walters, former director of the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy, "The pro-legalization movement hasn't come from a groundswell of the people. A great deal of its funding and fraud has been perpetrated by George Soros and his organizations, and then promoted by left-wing celebrities". These include, Louise Arbour, a former judge on the Supreme Court of Canada, George Schultz, former US Secretary of State, Kofi Annan, former Secretary General of the UN, Ghana, Nick Clegg, former Deputy Prime Minister of the UK, and Richard Branson, entrepreneur, advocate for social causes and founder of the Virgin Group, consisting of 400 companies. The presence of these Soros funded groups led to a salvo of headlines. "The war on drugs is dead," "We must reform our drug laws". The Washington Post wrote that "More than 1,000 world leaders say the drug war has been a disaster" while the Huffington Post wrote of "Censorship and exclusion on Day One of UNGASS". Soros' organizations made quite a stir at the meeting when they were escorted by a squad of actors in 1920's prohibition costumes in theatrical fashion to indicate it's time to move on from prohibition. The legalizer banners read "Nice People Do Drugs" and their messaging was direct: "Stop stigmatizing drug users", placing blame for drug users' misfortunes at the feet of proponents of prohibition. They ranted, "No children are saved by putting mothers behind bars."

On the other hand, today's world leaders at this meeting reaffirmed the UN drug treaties. These treaties are the

cornerstone principles of the global drug control system, emphasizing the health and welfare of humankind as the founding purpose of these treaties.

CANADIAN MINISTER OF HEALTH ATTENDS UN MEETING.

The Canadian Minister of Health, Jane Philpott attended the UN UNGASS meeting. She selected April 20th, 4/20 of all days and at the UN of all places, when pot users in Canada openly demonstrated their disregard for the law on marijuana, to announce that the Canadian government was willing to go off side of the UN by implementing legalization of marijuana in 2017. HEALTH MINISTER WASTES PUBLIC MONEY PRO-MOTING CANADA'S OPEN MARIJUANA POLICY

The Minister of Health took a large delegation with her to New York, all at the taxpayers' expense. Those offered a free trip to New York were youth, indigenous people, and women who have suffered the loss of children from overdosing on opioids. The media picked up their stories and captions read, "The war on drugs has been a war on families." We learned that members of this delegation were brought to Ottawa, where they were briefed and then had their travel

expenses covered to support the Minister in New York. It was an orchestrated performance. We spoke with First Nations members of the delegation, who admitted that they had come along to advance their own agenda for recovery programs, but that they were not onside with the Government and also volunteered that they were offended that the indigenous voice was being bought and used in such a way.

CONDEMNATION OF COUNTRIES DEFYING UN DRUG TREATIES

Werner Sipp, the President of the UN International Narcotics Control Board spoke at UNGASS on April 19th, and condemned those countries which, "defy the international consensus upon which international cooperation depends" by legalizing drugs for non-medical uses. This condemnation obviously included Canada.

Canada has the highest rate of use of marijuana by youth in the industrialized world. The government has expressed its desire to show the rest of the world how to legalize marijuana "the right way". This is the height of arrogance, and its

position is pure politics, not sound public health policy. Given Canada's high rates of use, we are the last country that should be showing any other country how to legalize the drug.

The fact is that the historical record and the worldwide fluctuations in rates clearly demonstrate that when prohibition and strong anti-drug messaging is delivered, the demand for and use of drugs are reduced such as has occurred in Sweden.

GEORGE SOROS' LEGALIZATION ATTEMPT DEFEATED

George Soros and his campaigners did not win the day at UNGASS 2016. The outcome document of UNGASS shows that legalization is a minority opinion—most UN Member States support the UN conventions opposing drug use. Countries which voiced strong opposition to reducing stringent drug laws included Russia, China, Indonesia, Saudi Arabia and Iran, but they were backed by most other countries as well.

With all his money which he distributes to his many liberal causes using high profile names to support him, but with no grass roots support, George Soros is having problems promoting his personal agenda. *

HOMOSEXUAL ACTIVISTS FUNDED THROUGH CANADIAN EMBASSIES

Gay activism, GLBTIQ (Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgender, Intersex and Queer), has caused divisions in Canadian society, within political parties over the redefinition of marriage, in the education system with GLBTQI propaganda trampling parental rights and responsibilities, at the United Nations with the GLBTQI lobby ignoring legitimate treaties which do not include protection of their sexual activities. Now Canada is complicit in spreading this social unrest to unsuspecting third world countries by providing funds to local GLBTIQ groups by way of Canadian embassies.

Following our previous coverage, Foreign Affairs Minister John Baird's Homosexual Legacy, REALity, February 2016, we have obtained further information which reveals widespread gay activism unfortunately funded by the unknowing Canadian taxpayer. Using the euphemisms, Protecting Human Rights, and Supporting Democratic Transition, tax dollars are funneled through Foreign Affairs, (now called Global Affairs Canada (GAC)), under the Canada Fund for Local Initiatives (CFLI). With little control from Global Affairs, these funds are used freely by special interest groups in these foreign centres to engage in political activism "paid out to them by the Canadian Embassies."

ACCESS TO INFORMATION REVEALS A WIDE-SPREAD NETWORK

An Access to Information request reports 66 GLBTI groups received \$1,332,057 in funding between 2012 and 2015. Information on nine projects was censured, not providing any data on the project, group, and/or country

receiving funding. The reason given was related to security, defence, subversion and intelligence, obviously not related to GLBT human rights and is not the real reason this information is not disclosed. They just don't want us to have this information. Why? A complaint has been made about this withheld information.

Thirty-eight different countries have received Canadian funding for GLBTI activism through our embassies. With a Liberal government and a Prime Minister who plans to join the Toronto Gay Pride Parade, this can be expected to escalate. We do know from the information received that \$26,630 in 2012 was paid out for the development of a handbook to promote LGBT rights. Interestingly, the country and organization involved in this project were blacked out in the Access to Information report.

FUNDING IS ONGOING AND INCREASING

Some of the foreign LGBT groups receiving Canadian funding include:

- Training LGBTI in communication and media skills in Uganda to advance the "struggle for LGBTI human rights", contrary to the general culture's strong family institutions, cost Canadians \$32,443 in 2012, with further \$50 and \$25 thousands for other advocacy in 2013 and 2014.
- Establishing a new activist LGBT NGO called "The Grace" in the Kyrgyz Republic to "increase capacity to promote democratic principles and equality through media advocacy" cost \$14,200 in 2013 with a further \$19,700 in 2014.
- · Under the guise of Supporting Democratic Transition,

Botswana received funds for "raising awareness of LGBTI rights through films, documentaries and discussions," **Malawi** was funded for "training, drama performances and awareness campaign" in 2012, and **India** for sensitization through cultural events in 2014.

- Purchase of furniture for the Gay and Lesbian Network office in **South Africa** cost Canadians \$5,146, with further funding for NGO's, health and law centres of \$19 and \$26 thousand in 2014.
- Pink Embassy, Human Rights House of Albania, received \$10,000 to raise awareness of hate speech in 2013, and \$15,000 to prepare an information toolkit for government services providers in 2015.
- Extensive promotion of same-sex marriage issues through "major awareness-raising workshops" for NGOs and government departments in **Viet Nam** received \$39,227 in 2012, followed up with \$30,607 for "sustaining the momentum of the current movement" in 2014.
- GALZ, Gays and Lesbians of **Zimbabwe**, received \$15,000 for a LGBTI Arts and Film Festival in 2013, as well as \$4,509 for sensitization workshops for journalists in 2015.

CANADIAN HOMOSEXUAL AND TRANSGENDER PROPAGANDA

There is no community left untargeted by Canadian tax dollars for the benefit of LGBTIQ:

- Activists in a Prison Centre and sensitization of journalists in **El Salvador**.
- Presidential elections in **Costa Rica** in 2013.
- Sensitization program among students in Georgia.
- Adolescents in correctional centres in **Mexico City**.
- LGBT victims of armed conflict in **Colombia**.
- Creating a hotline in Ukraine.

- · Training and advocacy in Turkey.
- Promoting LGBT gender equality in politics and sports in **Paraguay**.
- A police force in Costa Rica, high schools in Colombia, sports programs in Brazil, public policy awareness raising in Argentina, on it goes as activists aim to transform the world with our tax dollars.

Social warriors who envision themselves as "progressive" disregard the resulting divisions in western countries: expensive court interventions, livelihoods lost for not baking cakes, increased sexually transmitted diseases with subsequent increase in medical treatment costs, disruptions in social peace in schools, disregard for parental and religious rights, costly legislative processes in government.

Canada's Global Affairs, has become embroiled in intervening in the cultural life of family based countries, some having constitutions which require them to defend the "right to culture, tradition and religion" as well as "public order, public health and morals." This secretive GLBTIQ agenda is not what Canadians expect of their governments as they struggle to raise their families under excessive taxation. Gender confusion and GLBTIQ, etc., are not Canadian values rooted in our culture, but government funded fringe "progressive" experimentation promoted through Canadian embassies by well-connected special interest groups.

CRUELTYTO ANIMALS BUT NOT HUMAN BABIES-EH?

According to the Globe and Mail (April 30, 2016), almost every major fast food chain in North America – McDonalds, Starbucks, Burger King and Tim Hortons - are fussy about the eggs they use. They insist that their eggs come from hens that are being housed in specially furnished cages or maintained cage-free. This provides the hens room for a perch, etc. or to roam free, rather than being placed in the former "battery" type housing with limited space, which is used for 90% of the 40 million eggs laid in Canada each year.

What's behind the fight for this feathered freedom? It is public opinion and pressure via the power of social media and the internet. Activists and animal rights groups have, by this route, gained unprecedented influence in shaping the public's perceptions about the food industry.

Another example of public pressure to ease the lives of

animals is that meat processing plants now provide curved corrals for cattle to walk in as they're led to slaughter. This reduces the cattle's ability to see what's coming and also reduces their anxiety.

This humane treatment of animals campaign has been put in place to reduce anxiety and stress in the lives of creatures who are destined to become hamburgers and chicken nuggets.

This effective campaign has been based on videos by activists who have recorded undercover images depicting horrendous abuse: animals being punched, kicked or worse – and then these images have been broadcast.

Does this sound somewhat familiar? How about the images exposed on videos of Planned Parenthood, cruelly cutting up and then selling and trafficking the body parts of unborn babies aborted on its premises? Yet, it was the maker

of the videos, David Deleiden, who was charged by a Texas Grand Jury with a felony charge of allegedly tampering with government records, and a misdemeanour relating to buying human tissue (he pretended to be a purchaser of body parts). These charges were politically motivated, owing to a Planned Parenthood member who works in the District Attorney's Office, and also Planned Parenthood's donation of \$81,000 to the election campaign of the same District Attorney. No charges have been laid against Planned Parenthood.

Additionally, the abortion industry, which makes billions of dollars annually via the killing of unborn babies and the exploitation of their mothers, has been heavily lobbying Democrats in the US Congress to stop its investigation of their industry and Planned Parenthood. There are 98 Democrats in Congress who are demanding that the Select Panel on Infant Lives in Congress stop its investigations of Planned Parenthood and the abortion industry. They also want the panel to be dismantled, despite mounting evidence of the horrors taking place in Planned Parenthood facilities and throughout the industry. The abortion industry is buying its influence in Congress: evidence shows that top Democrats on the investigating panel have numerous ties to abortion advocates. This includes generous election funding made to them by the industry.

The pro-life movement in the US has been teaching the facts about unborn babies and abortion for years. These facts have spread, with the result that more women are rejecting abortion. Abortion clinics are closing at a rapid rate because of a lack of business. The number of abortions in

the US fell to a historic low in 2011. The 2011 teenage abortion rate was the lowest since 1973 when the US Supreme Court ruled in support of abortion on demand in *Roe vs. Wade*. This decline in teen abortions reflects a larger trend across the US. Even in the pro-abortion bellwether state of New York, in seven years (2008-2014), the abortion rate dropped 21%.

The pro-life movement in Canada has heroically been doing the same thing here — exposing the facts about abortion. As usual, although Canadians are slower to take notice and react than Americans. Our turn will come. Until then, if Canadians are worked up over the care of animals destined for the food industry, we will eventually get worked up over the fear, stress and pain caused to unborn children, who are poked, poisoned and torn to pieces by a suction machine during an abortion.

The Globe and Mail in an editorial (May 14, 2016) congratulated Canadians for their growing concern about animals. It stated:

We are recognizing the familiar, human-like traits of creatures who could formerly have been dismissed and mistreated as alien beings.

Then it stated:

Anyone who develops a deep relationship with a pet is wellplaced to extend that empathy to other creatures, including other humans.

Let's hope so! Canadians care about animals. Hopefully, this concern will extend to human babies very soon. *

WHY DON'T HOMOSEXUALS SOLVE THEIR OWN PROBLEMS?

Few individuals manage to get through life without problems. The problems are as varied as the individuals themselves, such as financial, health, family, employment, substance abuse, disabilities — the list is endless.

Most individuals try to solve their problems in order to lead a calmer and happier life. Others ignore their problems, hoping that they will just disappear, although, they rarely do. They just increase in urgency.

It appears that the lifestyle of homosexuals is causing them enormous problems, which they are completely ignoring.

- In 2013, Vancouver Coastal Health and the British Columbia Centre for Disease Control reported that levels of syphilis infections in homosexual and bisexual men were the highest they'd been in more than 30 years in the Vancouver area.
- 2. In Alberta, cases of gonorrhea among homosexuals last year were up 80% from 2014, while infectious syphilis cases doubled in 2015 from 2014.
- 3. The US Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reports that men who have sex with men face a syphilis

infection rate at the highest it's been since the 1980s, before HIV appeared on the horizon.

On its fact sheet the CDC states that there is a "Troubling rise in syphilis infections among men, particularly gay and bisexual men," ... the rates of syphilis are increasing at an alarming rate (15.1 percent) in 2014. It went on to say: "while rates have increased among both men and women, men account for more than 90 percent of all primary and secondary syphilis cases. Men who have sex with men (MSM) account for 83 percent of male cases where the sex of the sex partner is known".

4. The UK's "Public Health England", in 2015, released a study indicating a sharp increase in syphilis and gonorrhea among gay men. "Syphilis infection can also place a person at increased risk for acquiring or transmitting HIV infection," it says. "Available surveillance data indicate that an average of half of MSM who have syphilis are also infected with HIV."

It is most puzzling that homosexuals are ignoring their

own grave health problems. Death and destruction haunt their lifestyle, causing sorrow, illness and personal rejection. Yet, there is no concerted attempt to change their behaviour.

Syphilis, a major killer in the 1800s, declined steadily after the Second World War period and had almost disappeared in Canada by the 1990s. But incidences began to climb again around 2001, with the per-capita rate doubling in 10 years with the number of cases now reaching more than a 3,000 a year in Canada.

At the same time that syphilis has emerged as a significant health problem, doctors are struggling to cope with a shortage of the main drug used to treat this potentially deadly infection.

The Public Health Agency of Canada took the rare step recently of posting guidelines on how to ration the drug, Bicillin, effectively in order to deal with syphilis.

"It is very, very concerning to us to have supply of this drug run out, because we are in a period of resurgence of syphilis in many parts of Canada," said Dr. Ameeta Singh, an Edmonton infectious-disease specialist and national syphilis expert.

Yet, homosexuals persist in their promiscuous lifestyle, claiming that it is an integral part of who they are. One would

think that they would want to at least <u>try</u> to curb their serious health problems by changing their sexual behaviour, especially with the shortage of the drug. But they don't.

According to Dr. Karen Campbell, Chief Medical Officer of Health in Alberta, social media is helping homosexuals arrange anonymous sexual encounters. As a result, the standard public health procedure of tracking down contacts for preventative purposes cannot be followed. The infection therefore becomes uncontrolled. The sex partners don't even want to know each other's names, and can't be bothered to take precautions during their sex acts. Bath houses and bars are now passé for homosexuals who don't want to get to know their prospective sex partners. Socializing just delays their objective — the sex act. Drugs and alcohol increase their carelessness while they seek this pleasure.

Homosexuals regard their anonymous sexual encounters as their entitlement and right. Their promiscuous behaviour, according to them, has to be tolerated and accepted by others. In short, it's not their problem, and society just has to pay for the health consequences of their behaviour. That is, everybody now pays for the homosexual lifestyle. ‡
